## Woodland Ferns

Ferns are perennials that produce evergreen or deciduous leaf-like structures known as fronds. They belong to the Pteridophytes, a group of plants that lack flowers and reproduce by spores rather than seeds. Ferns provide attractive foliage and they generally prefer damp, shaded areas. They are highly valued for the elegant symmetry of their fronds and the textural contrast of their lush foliage. Once established, ferns usually require little maintenance.
